### Executive Summary

- Batch 13 commenced on May 7 and, as of early July, has reached the midway point of SSDC's four-month program.
- The batch comprises 34 students, carefully selected from over 65 applicants, reflecting SSDC's commitment to quality and potential-driven admissions.
- Key highlights so far include:
  - Field visits to other TSF initiatives around Madanapalle
  - Self-esteem and life skills workshops with psychologist
  - Participation in International Yoga Day
  - Marked World Blood Donor Day with several first-time donors.



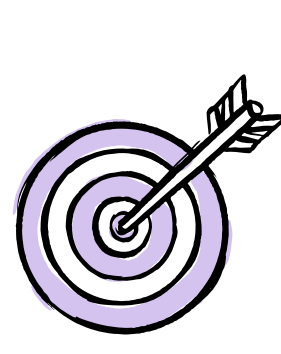
### About us

The Satsang Skill Development Centre (SSDC), an initiative of The Satsang Foundation, was established in November 2018 in Madanapalle, Andhra Pradesh, to bridge the gap between academic learning and real-world employability. Its four-month program equips underserved youth with practical skills in English, Mathematics, and Computer Literacy, while also nurturing interpersonal communication, decision-making, and values-based personal growth. With an emphasis on experiential learning, SSDC supports young adults in building confidence, purpose, and readiness for meaningful careers.

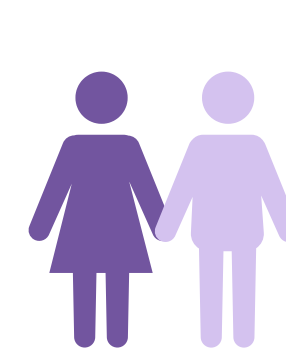

### Introducing Batch 13

Over the years, SSDC has quietly established itself as a trusted provider of employment-focused training, letting outcomes speak rather than marketing campaigns. Located away from the main town, the Centre continues to draw students from nearby and far-off areas — some even travelling up to 80 km daily by local buses with limited frequency. This speaks as much to their determination as to the quiet ripple the program is beginning to create in the surrounding communities.

This confidence stems from a consistent 98% placement rate, supported by reliable recruitment partnerships and organic community awareness of SSDC's comprehensive training approach. The focus extends beyond mere job preparation to encompass broader life skills development.

The recent Batch 13 selection process attracted 68 applications, reflecting SSDC's expanding influence and established credibility. Though designed for 25 students, the Centre accommodated 34 admissions to include worthy candidates who demonstrated genuine commitment, need and readiness. Selection involved conversations with students and families, home visits, and financial assessments — with the aim of ensuring a fair and thoughtful process for every applicant.



### More Than a Classroom

The new batch, which began on May 7th, includes 34 students in SSDC's thoughtfully crafted four-month classroom program. The curriculum encompasses:

- Foundation Skills: Spoken English, applied mathematics, and computer literacy
- Interpersonal Skills: Communication, teamwork, decision-making, and self-management
- Applied Learning: Hands-on lab sessions and practical applications
- Holistic Development: Team building, creative workshops, and personal reflection

The program ensures equal opportunity regardless of background, promotes comprehensive growth in technical and personal skills, and creates lifelong impact through sustainable development foundations.



